### **Contaminated Land Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)**

#### **Adoption Statement**

The Contaminated Land SPD has been produced to give guidance to developers on assessing and mitigating the potential effects of contamination where this may exist and sets out the way the Borough Council considers contaminated land issues as part of development management proposals.
